Monday Memorial Feast of St Cornelius & St Cyprian. Cornelius was Pope in 251. He was supported by Cyprian who was Bishop of Carthage - both were martyred.

Friday Sts Andrew Kim Taegon & Companions. Martyred in the 19th Century during the terrible persecution that occurred in Korea. 103 of the Christian Community were martyred - mostly lay people who suffered greatly for their faith.
