

The 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary commemorating the anniversary of those who


Fought on D-Day and at Monte Cassino. 1944

There will be a minute's silence before the 11 am Mass.




## The Novena to Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal

#### Monday is memorial feast of St Martin of Tours.

Bishop of Tours.

#### Friday Albert the Great

A Dominican friar and Bishop. He combined the

He died in 1280.
