



Feasts this week

26th Feast of St Stephen the first martyr to be honoured on this first day of the twelve days of Christmas.

'Let us adore the new born Christ, today he has crowned St Stephen.'

Friday 27th Feast of St John Apostle and Evangelist one of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus according to the New Testament. He was the son of Zebedee and Salome, He died about 100 AD

Saturday 28th Feast of the Holy Innocents - Herod ordered the massacre of all boys in Bethlehem and its vicinity - he feared the 'new borne King.'

Next Sunday Feast of the Holy Family Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

Today marks the Solemn opening of the Jubilee Year - (as of the archbishop's letter some weeks ago)
