



Through Christ we are heirs to this covenant.


2nd Reading

Gospel


We hear Luke's version of the transfiguration of Jesus on Tabor.

STATIONS OF THE Cross—Friday at 6.30pm followed by Mass

During the Week:

Monday 17th March—St. Patrick Bishop, Patron of Ireland. Born in Roman Britain, he was taken captive to Ireland as a slave. After his escape, he became a priest and as Bishop he organised the Church throughout Ireland. He is buried at Downpatrick.

Tuesday 18th March—St. Cyril of Jerusalem. Bishop and Doctor of the Church.

Wednesday 19th March—St. Joseph Secondary Patron of the Archdiocese. This feast celebrates St. Joseph as a devoted husband of the Virgin Mary and a foster father to Jesus. He was the protector of the Holy Family. Joseph is venerated as the patron saint of the Universal Church.
