

Memorial Feasts during the week

Wednesday - ferial feast of St Augustine Zhao Rong - a Chinese priest and 119 companions were martyred for their faith. The feast honours their steadfastness in the face of persecution in China and calls us to reflect on the sacrifices made in all times and places for believing and holding fast to the Gospel.

Friday 11th July St Benedict - Patron of Europe. Born in Umbria, he led a life of solitude and gathering disciples around him went on to Monte Casino where he founded a hilltop monastery in 529 that continues to the present day. Combining work and prayer he wrote a balanced and moderate rule which combines work and prayer which was widely influential and led to him being called the Father of Monasticism in the West.
